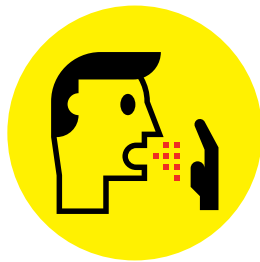
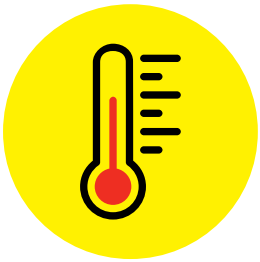


CORONAVIRUS

GOT SYMPTOMS? GET TESTED



Main symptoms of coronavirus

- A high temperature.
- A new, continuous cough.
- A loss or change to your sense of smell or taste.

Most people with coronavirus have at least 1 of these symptoms.

If you have any of the main symptoms of coronavirus:

- get a test to check if you have coronavirus as soon as possible
- stay at home and don't have visitors until you get your test result – only leave your home to have a test

Anyone you live with, and anyone in your support bubble, must also stay at home until you get your result.

You can book a test for yourself or a child online at bit.ly/2E8VQEc or by calling **119**. If you need help with your results call **0300 303 2713**.

If you cannot book a national test immediately, please try again at a later time as the system is currently very busy and your patience is appreciated.

If you cannot book a test please do not go to your GP or hospital emergency department.

In Cornwall, we have access to 4 mobile testing units which usually operate from Falmouth, Launceston, St Austell, Bude or Camborne. Please check and book a slot before you attend. You will need to have a QR code to attend. Go to bit.ly/35IsO9Y to book your slot.

If you are a parent or carer and unable to book a local slot email d-ccg.cornwalldevon.urgenttesting@nhs.net explaining that the test is for a child attending a Cornwall school and they will be supported to access local testing.

Please continue to isolate until you have your test result and follow guidance.
